

2007-08 District and State Meet Contest & Room Conflict Pattern /Time Schedule One-Day, Grades 1-8 Tournament

This Conflict Pattern **MUST** be followed at both District and State meets. • Grades 1-5 = Elementary
• Grades 6-8 = Middle School. Only one contest may be entered during a time slot.
• **EXCEPTIONS:** Students in Poetry 6-8 may also enter these events in the Preliminary round: Number Sense and/or Math, On-Site Drawing, OR Ready Writing. For Poetry 6-8 Finals, contestants may also enter Science. (Dual entry is not permitted in Listening or Spelling.) Contestants in Impromptu Speaking **FINALS** may also be entered in Dictionary Skills. Contestants entered in Modern Oratory may also be entered in either Maps, Graphs & Charts OR Vocabulary. **Contestants in Poetry 4 or 5 may be entered in Ready Writing with a LATE speaking order.**
• Written notification of speech dual entry **SHALL** accompany district entries at least 30 days prior to the District Meet. Arrangements for the contestant to speak first (or **EARLY, except for Poetry 4 or 5**) in the round must be submitted to the meet director in writing **at least 7 days prior to the State Meet**. Contestants will **NOT** be given additional time if contests in which they have been entered in conflict with **SPEECH** have started when they enter the room. Only the speech contests named above will have the dual entry option with a conflicting contest, as named above. **THIS SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE MUST BE FOLLOWED AT BOTH THE DISTRICT AND STATE MEETS.**
