

Dedicated volunteers make the difference

As veteran participants and district meet hosts of the PSIA organization well know, it takes many people to run a quality academic tournament. In the 2004 "AA" State Meet alone, 292 positions were filled by volunteers, and an additional 103 positions were filled by speech and On-Site Drawing judges, who were paid a pittance for their service. Add the "A" meet volunteers to the count, and the number of positions served to enable privately-schooled children to compete at the state level reaches over 700.

The concept of service was the focal point of a speech given by Fort Worth

Star Telegram Vice-President and Editorial Director, Paul K. Harral, as he honored Guardianship Services "Volunteers of the Year" at a luncheon in April. We were honored that Bruce was recipient of one of the Volunteer of the Year awards for his work with handicapped individuals through this organization. The countless hours of unpaid service he also provides for PSIA were not even a consideration.

Mr. Harral pointed out that service has been recognized through the ages by many honorable writers and public figures. He first quoted Henrik Ibsen,

Service brings personal reward

poet and playwright who once said: "A community is like a ship; everyone ought to be prepared to take the helm"?

The prize fighter Mohammed Ali once said: "Service to others is the rent you pay for your room here on earth."

British statesman Edmund Burke said: "The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing"

Mr. Harral went on to quote several others, but these stand out as dominant examples of the impact of service.

"No matter how big and powerful government gets, and the many services it provides, it can never take the place of volunteers," said President Ronald Reagan.

Mother Teresa said: "We ourselves feel that what we are doing is just a drop in the ocean. But the ocean would be less because of that missing drop."

Winston Churchill said: "We make a living by what we do, but we make a life by what we give."

The columnist Erma Bombeck said: "Volunteers are the only human beings on the face of the earth who reflect this nation's compassion, unselfish caring, patience, and just plain love for one another."

As former Michigan Governor and one time presidential candidate George Romney said: "The magnitude of our social problems will require that all citizens and institutions make a commitment to volunteering as a way of life and as a primary opportunity to create needed change ..."

What are the requirements to serve?

Dr. Martin Luther King described them this way: "Everyone can be great because anyone can serve. You don't have to have a college degree to serve. You don't even have to make your subject and your verb agree ... You only need a heart full of grace. A soul generated by love..."

Mr. Harral went on to say that we volunteer because we see the opportunity

to match a need with a skill. But most of all, we volunteer because it makes us feel good about ourselves.

Anthropologist Margaret Mead noted: "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world; indeed, it's the only thing that ever has."

And the first President George Bush said: "Every problem that the country faces is being solved in some community by some group or some individual. The question is how to get connected so that the whole nation can solve problems."

And the noted philosopher Aesop said: "No act of kindness, no matter how small, is ever wasted ..."

Mr. Harral closed his speech with a poem that he found on the website of the North Carolina 4-H Clubs. He said of this poem, "If this isn't Scripture, it ought to be."

*Many will be shocked to find,
When the day of judgment nears,
That there's a special place in Heaven
Set aside for volunteers.
Furnished with big recliners,
Satin couches and footstools:
Where there's no committee chairman,
No group leaders - or carpools.
No eager team that needs a coach,
No bazaar and no bake sale;
There will be nothing to staple,
Not one thing to fold or mail.
Telephone lists will be outlawed,
But a finger snap will bring
Cool drinks and gourmet dinners
And rare feasts fit for a king.*

*You ask, "Who will serve these privileged few
And work for all they're worth?"*

*Why, all those who reaped the benefit and
